Dear Spring Lake Resident:

It's that time again to share some important information with you regarding beach sales and other Borough business.

EMERGENCY NOTIFICATIONS

Please be certain that you can receive information from The Borough in the event of an emergency. **IMPORTANT:** The Borough is phasing out our current Website provider and their notifications. Beginning January, 2015 we will issue all emergency notifications from the **CODE RED EMERGENCY NOTIFICATIONS**. If you have not already done so, please register your contact information at www.springlakeboro.org (bottom left of home page) or www.springlakepolice.org (scroll to the bottom, the link is on the right). You can include multiple contacts including your home phone, cell phone and email.

DOG AND CAT LICENSING

DOGS: Owners of all dogs seven month or older are required to apply annually for a dog license. All applicants must present proof of a rabies vaccination from a licensed veterinarian.

CATS: Owners of all cats are required to apply annually for a cat license. All applicants must present proof of a rabies vaccination from a licensed veterinarian.

All license applications must be submitted online at www.springlakeboro.org The licensing year is January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2015.

Directions: At the top of the Home Page, select "Departments", then select "Clerk and Registrar". Midway down on this page, you'll find a hotlink for "Dog and Cat Licensing". Click here. From there you will be redirected to Community Pass, the Borough's online system for program and activity registration. If you're an existing user, go to the right side of the screen and login. If you're not yet a user, follow the instructions on the left side of the screen to "Create Your Account".

Once you're logged in, select "Pet Licensing" from the "Select Activity" dropdown menu under the "Register Now" section. From there, follow the instructions. Payment may be made with a check or credit card.

Please make note of the following **NEW FEES** for pet licensing:

Pet Type	Spayed/Neutered	Non-spayed/Non-neutered
Dog	\$12.00	\$15.00
Cat	\$5.00	\$8.00

LATE FEE – \$5.00 - Assessed if pet is licensed after **February 28, 2015**.

REPLACEMENT FEE – \$3.50 – Assessed to replace a lost tag.

GARAGE SALE PERMITS

Residents interested in hosting a garage sale must have a permit and may now apply online. Permits are issued in accordance with the following:

- Sales may not take place in the FRONT YARD of any premises.
- Sales may not take place on a Sunday or Legal Holiday.
- A permit will be issued for not more than two (2) consecutive days. If the second day is a Sunday or Legal Holiday, the permit will be valid for the first business day thereafter.
- One sign (no larger than 24" x 24") is allowed on the premises. No signs are permitted off premises.
- Only one permit will be issued for any given premises for any twelve (12) month period. In the event the premises is sold or transferred within the twelve (12) month period, an additional permit may be issued.
- Fee: \$5.00

Midway down on this page, you'll find a hotlink for "Garage Sale Permit". Click here. From there you will be redirected to Community Pass, the Borough's online system for program and activity registration. If you're an existing user, go to the right side of the screen and login. If you're not yet a user, follow the instructions on the left side of the screen to "Create Your Account".

Once you're logged in, select "Garage Sale Permit" from the "Select Activity" dropdown menu under the "Register Now" section. From there, follow the instructions. Payment may be made with a check or credit card.

BOAT REGISTRATION PERMITS

Residents and nonresidents interested in storing a boat at any of the three (3) bodies of water in Spring Lake may now apply for a permit online. Permits are issued in accordance with the following:

- Registrants must present evidence of a paid insurance policy covering public liability for injury to any person or persons in the amount of \$300,000 per occurrence.
- Registrants must agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Borough of Spring Lake against all loss and damage, including damage to person or property, arising from any act by, or negligence of the registrant or their friends, relative or otherwise while engaged in the performance of this Ordinance, or while in or about the premises, or arising from accident or any injury not caused by act of Borough. The registrant further

acknowledges that the use of the boats by themselves, friends, relatives or otherwise do so at their own risk.

- Registrants must be prepared to remove their boat no later than October 31st or they will be subject to removal fee of \$100.00 and a storage fee of \$100.00 per month, pro-rated daily. Any boats remaining in the Borough's possession after February 1st, shall be considered abandoned.
- Resident Fee: \$30.00
- Nonresident Fee: \$75.00

Midway down on this page, you'll find a hotlink for "Boat Permit". Click here. From there you will be redirected to Community Pass, the Borough's online system for program and activity registration. If you're an existing user, go to the right side of the screen and login. If you're not yet a user, follow the instructions on the left side of the screen to "Create Your Account".

Once you're logged in, select "Boat Permit" from the "Select Activity" dropdown menu under the "Register Now" section. From there, follow the instructions. Payment may be made with a check or credit card.

Contractor Signs: A reminder that contractors performing work at your home are not allowed to place signs on your property.

Reclamation Center Stickers: Just a reminder ... if you haven't picked up your sticker already, please stop into Borough Hall and pick up your 2015-2016 sticker.
