Tree Replacement Plan: Shall consist of the following

 Site plan, survey or plot plan (1"=20') showing location, number, caliper (4" or greater) and species of existing trees to be removed.

Replacement requirements: Caliper (diameter) measured @ 54" above ground

Size of Tree Removed Number of Replacement Trees with at Least 2 1/2

4 but not more than 6 - 1 Tree

More than 6 but less than 10 - 2 Trees

More than 10 but less than 16 - 3 Trees

More than 16 - 4 Trees

Replacement Fund: In lieu of planting replacement trees:

Size/DBH Replacement tree value

Greater than 4 inches up to 6 inches - \$400.00

Greater than 6 inches up to 10 inches - \$800.00

Greater than 10 inches up to 16 inches - \$1,200.00

Greater than 16 inches - \$1,500.00

Note: In the event a tree(s) were removed from a site without a permit and without prior approval, the number of trees requiring mitigation shall be computed by assuming that 10 trees with a caliper of 12" or more were removed unless adequate proof is approved by the Code Enforcement Officer.

Recommended deciduous street trees: Sycamore, Willow Oak, Red Maple (not Japanese or swamp variety), Green Spire Littleleaf Linden, Pear Trees (Red Spire & Aristocrat) and Red Oak.

<u>Right of Way:</u> That area between the sidewalk and the curbing along the street cartways.
