

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING ORDINANCE NUMBER 20-2002 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, ADOPTED AUGUST 9, 1993, IN ORDER TO CREATE AND ESTABLISH AN EMERGENCY SERVICES VOLUNTEER LENGTH OF SERVICE AWARDS PROGRAM (LOSAP) IN THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE PURSUANT TO P.L. 1997, C. 388 (N.J.S.A. 40A:14-183 ET SEQ.) FOR THE SPRING LAKE FIRST AID SQUAD UNDER, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH, AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE AND THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE HEIGHTS" ADOPTED AUGUST 12, 2002

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 20-2002 was adopted by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Spring at a meeting held on August 12, 2002; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to amend said Ordinance to include the following paragraph to clarify issues which have been raised with respect to said Ordinance; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Spring Lake, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, that Ordinance No. 20-2002 be and is hereby amended to include the following:

Section 3.

New Paragraph "H" which shall read as follows:

H. Any volunteer who resigns from volunteer duty shall not be eligible to rejoin the LOSAP program for a period of one year commencing January 1st of the year following their successful reentry into the volunteer organization. In addition, it is noted that any vesting requirement shall begin from the one year date. Should member whose has previously resigned choose at a later date to rejoin the organization, they must do so as a "new" member and cannot use any previous service credit(s). No member can rejoin the organization within one (1) year of resignation.

Section 2.

If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provisions so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective; and

Section 3.

Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of the Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict; and

Section 4.

This ordinance shall take effect on upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.
