

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 114, SECTION 7
"WEAPONS, BICYCLES ON THE BOARWALK OR BEACHES" OF THE CODE OF THE
BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE, MONMOUTH COUNTY, NEW JERSEY.**

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Spring Lake, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 114, Section 7, "Weapons, bicycles on the boardwalk or beaches subsection C. shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 1.

C. No person shall ride a bicycle on the boardwalk commencing on May 15 of each year and continuing thereafter to September 15, inclusive, of each year, except during the hours from sunrise ~~5:00 a.m.~~ 8:00 a.m., prevailing time, or each day. This does not apply to bicycles operated by the Borough of Spring Lake or its Police Department in carrying out the duties and responsibilities in protecting the health, safety and welfare of the general public.

Section 2.

If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provisions so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective; and

Section 3.

Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of the Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict; and

Section 4.

This ordinance shall take effect on upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.
