

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 376, SECTION 45
"CHARGES FOR TAPPING WATER MAIN AND OPENING STREET" OF THE CODE OF THE
BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE, MONMOUTH COUNTY, NEW JERSEY.**

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Spring Lake, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 376, Section 45, "Charges for tapping water main and opening street" subsections A and B. shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 1.

A. A charge for tapping water main with service pipe to curb, including corporation and curb stops and including a street excavation not exceeding 35 lineal feet, shall be made as follows:

1. For one-inch pipe on:
 - a. Bituminous surface treated roads: \$1,600.
 - b. Concrete Roads: \$1,950.
2. ~~For one and one-half inch pipe on:~~
For one-and-one-quarter-inch pipe on:
 - a. Bituminous surface treated roads: \$1,800.
 - b. Concrete Roads: \$2,200.
3. ~~For a two-inch pipe on:~~
For a one-and-one-half-inch pipe on:
 - a. Bituminous surface treated roads: \$2,200.
 - b. Concrete roads: \$2,700.

New Subsection "4" which shall read as follows:

4. For a two-inch pipe on:
 - a. Bituminous surface treated roads: \$2,600.
 - b. Concrete Roads: \$3,000.

B. Taps larger than two inches in size are to be made only on special arrangements with the Water Department, and the applicant shall pay the full and actual cost of the installation, but in no case less than a minimum charge of ~~\$2,700~~-\$3,000.

Section 2.

If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provisions so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective; and

Section 3.

Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of the Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict; and

Section 4.

This ordinance shall take effect on upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.
