

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING VARIOUS SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 376, WATER AND SEWER OF THE BOROUGH CODE

WHEREAS, Chapter 376, Water and Sewer, of the Borough Code governs water and sewer issues in the Borough of Spring Lake; and

WHEREAS, the following sections of Chapter 376 is amended and supplemented with deletions reflected in ~~strikethrough~~ and additions reflected in underline;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Spring Lake in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1.

§376-3 Applications for connections; fees; permits.

A. All applications for water or sewer service connections shall be made to the Borough Clerk or other authorized officer of the Borough of Spring Lake upon blank forms furnished by the Borough Clerk or other authorized officer of the Borough, and the same shall be accompanied by a fee in accordance with the following schedule:

(1) For each new sanitary sewer service connection: the sum of \$1,500.

(2) For each replacement of a present sanitary sewer service connection: the sum of ~~\$1,000.~~ \$1,500.

(3) For each cutoff of a present sanitary sewer service connection: the sum of ~~\$200.~~ \$300.

(4) The fee to discontinue water service up to a two-inch connection shall be ~~\$200~~ \$300; where the service is larger than a two-inch connection, the charge shall be the actual cost to the Borough but not less than \$1,000.

(5) For each new connection or replacement of a connection to the stormwater system up to six inches, the fee will be a sum of ~~\$200~~ \$300. For any connection to the stormwater system in excess of six inches, the fee will be determined by the Borough Water Superintendent and based upon the costs involved in making the connection.

B. All sewer and water service connection permits must be obtained prior to the issuance of a building permit, but the issuance of such a sewer and water connection permit shall be subject to the provisions of Chapter 225, Land Development, so that the issuance thereof shall give no guaranty that a building permit will be issued.

§376-9 Applications for connections; fees; permits.

A. All applications for water or sewer service connections shall be made to the Borough Clerk or other authorized officer of the Borough of Spring Lake upon blank forms furnished by the Borough Clerk or other authorized officer of the Borough, and the same shall be accompanied by a fee in accordance with the following schedule:

(1) For each new sanitary sewer service connection: the sum of \$1,500.00

(2) For each replacement of present sanitary sewer service connection: the sum of ~~\$1000.00~~ \$1,500.00

(3) For each cutoff of a present sanitary sewer service connection: the sum of ~~\$200.00~~ \$300.00

(4) The fee to discontinue water service up to a two inch connection shall be ~~\$200.00~~ \$300.00, where the service is larger than a two-inch connection, the charge shall be the actual cost to the Borough but not less than \$1000.00.

(5) For each new connection or replacement of a connection to the stormwater system up to six inches, the fee will be a sum of ~~\$200.00~~ \$1500.00. For any connection to the stormwater system in excess of six inches, the fee will be determined by the Borough Water Superintendent and based upon the costs involved in making the connection.

B. All sewer and water service connection permits must be obtained prior to the issuance of a building permit, but the issuance of such a sewer and water connection permit shall be subject to the provisions of Chapter 225, Land Development, so that the issuance thereof shall give no guaranty that a building permit will be issued.

§376-45 Charges for tapping water main and open street

A. A charge for tapping water main with service pipe to curb, including corporation and curb stops and including a street excavation not exceeding 35 lineal feet, shall be made as follows:

- 1. For one-inch pipe on:
 - a. Bituminous & Concrete surface treated roads: ~~\$1,600.~~ \$1,950.00.
 - b. ~~Concrete Roads: \$1,950.~~
- 2. For one-and-one-quarter-inch pipe on:
 - a. Bituminous & Concrete surface treated roads: ~~\$1,800.~~ \$2,200.00.
 - b. ~~Concrete Roads: \$2,200.~~
- 3. For a one-and-one-half-inch pipe on:
 - a. Bituminous & Concrete surface treated roads: ~~\$2,200.~~ \$2,700.00
 - b. ~~Concrete roads: \$2,700.~~
- 4. For a two-inch pipe on:
 - a. Bituminous & Concrete surface treated roads: ~~\$2,600.~~ \$3,000.00
 - b. ~~Concrete Roads: \$3,000.~~

B. Taps larger than two inches in size are to be made only on special arrangements with the Water Department, and the applicant shall pay the full and actual cost of the installation, but in no case less than a minimum charge of ~~\$3,000~~ \$4,000.00.

§376-59 Test of meter; fee; adjustment of bill.

The Water Department will, at the request of any consumer, test the meter upon the payment of a fee of ~~\$100~~ \$200, payable in advance. If the meter is found to be fast, bills rendered will be adjusted with the understanding that, when the test is made, the meter or meters will record within 2% of absolute correctness upon ordinary size flows or openings. In no case shall there be an adjustment of less than the minimum of the annual service charge. If the meter is found to be fast, the test fee shall be refunded to the consumer or owner.

Section 2.

If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provisions so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective; and

Section 3.

Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of the Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict; and

Section 4.

This ordinance shall take effect on upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.


