

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 100-23 OF THE BOROUGH CODE, "ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES", OF THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE

WHEREAS, Chapter 100, "Alcoholic Beverages", Article II, §100-23 sets forth the regulations within the Borough of Spring Lake regarding Public Consumption within the Borough; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Spring Lake, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 100, "Alcoholic Beverages", Article II "§100-23. Public Consumption", is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

Section 1.

No person shall possess and/or consume in an open bottle, open can, glass, cup or other open container any beer, wine or other alcoholic beverage on the public streets, on the sidewalks, on the beach, on the boardwalk, in the public parks or in any other public place, including but not limited to, any automobile, bicycle or any other vehicle which is traveling, stopped or parked on any public street or in any other public place within the Borough of Spring Lake.

Section 2.

If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provisions so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective; and

Section 3.

Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of the Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict; and

Section 4.


This ordinance shall take effect on upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.
