

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING ORDINANCE NUMBER 20-2002 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, ADOPTED AUGUST 9, 1993, IN ORDER TO CREATE AND ESTABLISH AN EMERGENCY SERVICES VOLUNTEER LENGTH OF SERVICE AWARDS PROGRAM (LOSAP) IN THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE PURSUANT TO P.L. 1997, C. 388 (N.J.S.A. 40A:14-183 ET SEQ.) FOR THE SPRING LAKE FIRST AID SQUAD UNDER, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH, AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE AND THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE HEIGHTS" ADOPTED AUGUST 12, 2002

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 20-2002 was adopted by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Spring at a meeting held on August 12, 2002; and

**WHEREAS**, it has become necessary to amend said Ordinance to amend Section 3(g) as to the amount of contribution to qualified members.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Spring Lake, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, that Ordinance No. 20-2002 be and is hereby amended to include the following:

**Section 3.**

**Paragraph "G" shall be amended to read as follows:**

- G. The maximum contribution, under this program, to be made to each active volunteer member, who qualifies, shall be One Thousand One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,150.00) per year.

**Section 2.**

If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provisions so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective; and

**Section 3.**

Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of the Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict; and

**Section 4.**

This ordinance shall take effect on upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.
