



Commemorative Tree Planting Program

The Commemorative Tree Planting Program is a vital component of **Canopy 2050, the Spring Lake Shade Tree Committee's** long-term initiative to preserve and strengthen Spring Lake's tree canopy for generations to come.

For a tax-deductible donation of \$1500, a commemorative tree may be planted in honor or memory of a person or pet, for a special event or occasion, or just in support of our tree canopy. This donation includes tree acquisition, planting, staking, mulching, watering, and monitoring the tree, as well as a one-year guarantee.

The commemorative tree will be planted in one of four Spring Lake parks: **Divine Park, Potter Park, Marucci Park, or Paziienza Park**. The donor may indicate their park preference. While we cannot guarantee that the donor will get their first choice of park, every effort will be made to accommodate their preference. The Spring Lake Department of Public Works, in consultation with the Spring Lake Shade Tree Committee and the donor, will make the final determination of tree location and tree species based on proper site conditions for the long-term health of the individual tree.
