

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 18, ARTICLE II BOARD OF RECREATION COMMISSIONERS; RECREATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND CHAPTER 86 RECREATION, DEPARTMENT OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SPRING LAKE, NEW JERSEY.

WHEREAS, Chapter 18, Article II provides for a Board of Recreation Commissioners and a Recreation Advisory Committee, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 86 provides for the Department of Recreation, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council have discussed the need to make changes to these sections to reflect the current needs of the Borough and its Recreation Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council that Chapters 18, Article II and Chapter 86 be and the same are hereby amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE II. Board of Recreation Commissioners; Recreation Advisory Committee [Adopted by Ord. No. 3-1985 (§ 2-39 of the Revised General Ordinances); amended in its entirety 12-12-2006 by Ord. No. 21-2006]

§ 18-6. Establishment, composition, term and appointment of Board of Recreation Commissioners.

- A. A Board of Recreation Commissioners is hereby established in the Borough.
- B. The Board of Recreation Commissioners shall consist of three members appointed by the Mayor. The Board members shall be ~~citizens and residents of the Borough of Spring Lake and shall be~~ members of the Council of the Borough of Spring Lake.
- C. The three members of the Board of Recreation Commissioners shall initially be appointed for terms of one and two ~~and three~~ years. Thereafter, all appointments shall be for a term of three years. Vacancies in the term of any Commissioner shall be filled for the unexpired term only. Commissioners shall serve until their respective successors are appointed and qualified. Commissioners shall receive no compensation for their services.

§ 18-7. Powers of Board of Recreation Commissioners; finances.

The Board of Recreation Commissioners shall have such powers and the Board shall receive such financial aid from the Borough as shall be authorized by the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:12-1 et seq. or as authorized by the Mayor and Council in accordance with other applicable law.

§ 18-8. ~~Recreational benefits for residents; exception. (Reserved)~~

~~All recreational activities authorized and conducted by the Board of Recreation Commissioners shall be solely for the use and the benefit of the residents of the Borough, except the Swim Team. The Swim Team shall consist of Borough residents and any other person who has a valid seasonal pool badge for the North End Pool or the South End Pool and who are accordingly participating in the sharing of a locker, except as otherwise provided by law.~~

§ 18-9. Fees for recreational activities.

In accordance with the N.J.S.A. 40:12-5, as amended from time to time, the Board of Recreation Commissioners may charge and collect reasonable fees from participants or spectators or from both participants and spectators with respect to recreational activities. The amounts charged and collected shall be used for the expenses of the Board. All monies received by the Board shall be paid over to the Chief Financial Officer and the same duly deposited in a special fund, which special fund shall be under the control of the Board of Recreation Commissioners.

§ 18-10. Penalties for violations of Board rules.

Any person violating any provisions of this article or violating any of the rules, regulations and bylaws of the Board of Recreation Commissioners shall, upon conviction, be liable to the penalty provided in Chapter 1, Article II, General Penalty.

§ 18-11. Recreation Advisory Committee.

~~A. A Recreation Advisory Committee is hereby established in the Borough. The Committee shall act as an advisory agent to the Board of Recreation Commissioners and Mayor and Council on all recreational matters.~~

~~B. The Recreation Advisory Committee shall be composed of up to seven members who shall be residents of the Borough of Spring Lake. All members shall serve without compensation and shall be appointed by the Mayor.~~

~~C. Appointments to the Recreation Advisory Committee shall be as follows: four of the members shall be appointed for a term of two years and three of the members shall be appointed for a term of one year. Any vacancy occurring other than by the expiration of a term shall be filled for the unexpired term in the same manner as the original term.~~

§ 18-12. Powers and duties of Recreation Advisory Committee.

~~The powers and duties of the Recreation Advisory Committee shall be as follows:~~

~~A. Elect a Chairman, Vice Chairman and Secretary.~~

~~B. Schedule monthly meetings, with additional meetings to be called by the Chairman.~~

~~C. Advise the Board of Recreation Commissioners and the Mayor and Council regarding ordinances which affect the recreation of the Borough.~~

~~D. Advise the Board of Recreation Commissioners and the Mayor and Council as to the recreational needs of the Borough.~~

~~E. Advise the Planning Board and Environmental Commission concerning recreation and open space, including an annual review of the "recreation and open space" components of the Borough's Master Plan.~~

~~F. Advise the Borough regarding cultural and recreational programs and activities in cooperation with other public and private agencies and organizations, and provide specialized programs for the aged, the handicapped and other special purposes.~~

~~G. Advise the Supervisor of the Department of Recreation and recommend procedures and programs for the repair, maintenance, restoration and enhancement of the Borough's recreational facilities.~~

~~H. Undertake any other duties that may be assigned by the Board of Recreation Commissioners or the Mayor and Council.~~

§ 18-13. (Reserved)

CHAPTER 86. RECREATION, DEPARTMENT OF

§ 86-1. Establishment.

A Recreation Department is hereby established in the Borough.

§ 86-2. Composition and powers.

There shall be a Department of Recreation, the head of which shall be the Supervisor of Recreation, in and for the Borough of Spring Lake, which shall:

A. Administer, operate and formulate programs for indoor and outdoor sports and other athletic and recreational programs and activities for children and adults.

B. Administer and operate facilities, functions and activities relating to public recreation.

§ 86-3. Personnel and salaries.

A. The Recreation Department shall have the following personnel:

(1) Recreation Supervisor. The Supervisor of Recreation, who shall be appointed by the Mayor and shall report to the Borough Administrator and the Board of Recreation Commissioners.

(2) Assistant Recreation Supervisor, if needed. The Assistant Supervisor of Recreation shall report to the Recreation Supervisor.

B. The salary for the Supervisor of Recreation and the Assistant Supervisor of Recreation shall be paid by the Borough and set by the Borough Council upon the recommendation of the Borough Administrator and board of Recreation Commissioners.

§ 86-4. Exhibitions, concerts, games and contests; admission fees.

Upon approval of the Board of Recreation Commissioners, the Department of Recreation may sponsor, arrange and provide for the giving of indoor and outdoor exhibitions, concerts, games and contests, and may use and employ public property for such purposes. The Department may charge and collect, for the use of the Borough, a reasonable admission fee for each person entering or using facilities, exhibitions, concerts, games or contests provided in this chapter when authorized by the Borough Administrator.

§ 86-5. Rules and regulations.


The Department, with the approval of the Borough Administrator, may adopt reasonable rules, regulations and bylaws for the conduct of all persons while on or using such public or private property devoted to or being utilized for Borough recreational purposes by the Department of Recreation. Such rules and regulations shall be adequately displayed on such property being so utilized.


