**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-007**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 1  
GENERAL PROVISIONS, SECTIONS 3 & 4**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 1, Sections 3 & 4 of the Borough Code governs General Provisions in the Borough of Spring Lake; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council have recommended that the following section of Chapter 1 is amended and supplemented as it is in the best interests of the Borough; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Spring Lake in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey as follows:

**ARTICLE II GENERAL PENALTY**

**§ 1-3. Maximum penalty.**

A. For violation of any provisions of this Code or other ordinance of the Borough of Spring Lake, unless a specific penalty is otherwise provided in connection with the provision violated, the maximum penalty upon conviction of the violation shall be by one or more of the following: imprisonment in the county jail or in any place provided by the municipality for the detention of prisoners, for any term not exceeding 90 days, or by a fine not exceeding ~~\$2,000~~ **\$2,500**, or by a period of community service not exceeding 90 days.

B. For a violation of any Borough ordinance pertaining to unlawful solid waste disposal the minimum fine shall not exceed \$2,500 and the maximum fine shall not exceed \$10,000.

**§ 1-4. Minimum penalty.**

The Borough Council may prescribe that for the violation of any particular provision of the Code or of any particular ordinance at least a minimum penalty shall be imposed which shall consist of a fine which may be fixed at an amount not exceeding \$100 **\$250**. The court before which any person is convicted of violating any ordinance or Code provision shall have power to impose any fine, term of punishment, or period of community service not less than the minimum and not exceeding the maximum fixed in the Code or such ordinance.

This Ordinance shall take effect on upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.
